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SPRY CONCRETE PUMPS PTY LTD TERMS OF TRADE

In these Terms of Trade, we have used "we", "us" and "our" to refer to SPRY CONCRETE PUMPS PTY LTD and "you" to refer to you, our customer. By agreeing to acquire Services from us you agree to these Terms

1. ORDERS AND SUPPLY

- 1.1 If you place an order with us, we have no obligation to accept the order. The order will not be effective until we approve and accept the order by confirmation to you.
- 1.2 If we accept your order, we will use reasonable endeavours to supply the Services to you at the time we agree with you or the time specified in our Quote.
- 1.3 If we accept your order, you cannot cancel, modify or defer your order without our consent which we may withhold at our discretion. We may give our consent subject to any conditions we consider appropriate including, without limitation, charging a cancellation fee and being reimbursed for all losses we suffer as a direct or indirect consequence (including loss of profits) of your cancellation, modification or deferral.
- 1.4 We will charge you for the Supply if you fail or refuse to take or accept the Supply or indicate to us that you will fail to do so.

2. TITLE AND RISK

- 2.1 We shall retain title to the Concrete Line Pump.
- 2.2 You shall bear the risk of any damage to the Concrete Line Pump occurring at the Site.

3. PRICE AND PAYMENT

- 3.1 All our prices are exclusive of GST and other taxes and duties and you must pay those amounts in addition to our price. Such prices are specified in our Schedule of Rates.
- 3.2 The supply of the Services commences from the time our Concrete Line Pump leaves our premises and concludes when it is washed, cleaned, packed up and ready to leave the Site following the provision of the Services.
- 3.3 You must pay for Services you order from us by:
 - (a) paying the full price that we specify for the Services and associated costs before we supply the Services to you (in which case, we shall have no obligations to you until you have paid for the Services in full); or
 - (b) if we give our consent, paying the full price we specify within 30 days after the end of the month in which the Services are supplied to you; or
 - (c) if we provide you with a Quote which you accept, paying for the Services referred to in the Quote on the terms set out in the Quote
- 3.4 We may refuse consent to you ordering Services from us for payment on credit (that is, payment either pursuant to clause 3.3(b) or (c)), unless you have completed our customer application form and we have approved your application for credit based on the information in that form. We may revoke our consent at any time by written notice to you in which case you must immediately pay to us all amounts you owe us.
- 3.5 Our prices are subject to change without notice, unless you have received official notice in writing that your order or Quote has been accepted by us.
- 3.6 If we provide a Quote to you, it is based on information available to us at that time and we may charge you more or less than the amount quoted if our costs (e.g. the cost of labour, materials, transport, tax, exchange rates or other costs) change. Any Quote will be valid and open for your acceptance for 30 days from the date of the Quote.
- 3.7 All payments shall be made without set-off or deduction. Receipt of a cheque, bill of exchange, or other negotiable instrument will not constitute payment and you remain liable for payment until payment is received by us.
- 3.8 We may apportion payments to outstanding accounts as we see

4. DEFAULT

- 4.1 You will be in Default if:
 - (a) you fail to pay an amount due under these Terms by the due date for payment; or
 - (b) you commit a breach of any of your other obligations under these Terms, the Security or the terms of any other contract you have entered into, or enter into in the future, with us or one of our related entities; or
 - (c) you become insolvent, are wound up, have a receiver appointed, enter into any composition or arrangement with your creditors, do any act which would render you liable to be placed in liquidation or have a receiver appointed over your

- property, commit an act of bankruptcy, cease to be of full legal capacity, or die; or
- (d) an event or a series of events (whether related or not) occurs which, in our opinion, may cause a material adverse change in your ability to meet your obligations to us.
- 4.2 If you are in Default then we may, at our option, do any one or more of the following:
 - (a) charge you default interest at 10% per annum on any late payments calculated on a daily basis from the due date until the date payment is received;
 - (b) require you to remedy the default in the manner and within the period that we tell you;
 - (c) require you to pay to us all amounts you owe us immediately;
 - (d) suspend or terminate your account with us;
 - (e) enforce security interests created by these Terms; and/or
 - (f) exercise any rights that we have under these Terms, any security or that are available to us at law.
- 4.3 We may suspend or terminate your account with us at any time in our sole discretion. If your account is terminated, you must immediately pay us any amount you owe us. Termination will not affect any of our rights that have arisen before termination.

5. WARRANTIES

- 5.1 The Competition and Consumer Act 2010 and Competition and Consumer Act 2010, Schedule 2 (Australian Consumer Law), and other statutes may impose warranties, conditions or obligations upon us which cannot by law (or which can only to a limited extent by law) be excluded. Other than expressly provided for in these Terms, we exclude all such imposed warranties, conditions or obligations to the extent permitted by law and exclude any warranty, condition or obligation imposed or implied under common law, equity or otherwise.
- 5.2 The guarantees contained in the Australian Consumer Law are excluded where you acquire goods and services from us for the purposes of a business.

6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- 6.1 Except as expressly otherwise provided by clauses 6.2 or 6.3, we shall not be liable for any loss or damage or liability of any kind whatsoever (including but not limited to special, consequential or incidental loss, penalty or lost profit revenues or business, loss of use of equipment and costs of substitute equipment or facilities) whether suffered or incurred by you or another person and whether in contract, tort (including negligence), warranty, liability, equity otherwise and whether such loss or damage arises directly or indirectly from Services provided by us to you, by delay in supply of the Services or for any other reason.
- 6.2 To the extent that we are liable for any reason for any loss suffered or liability incurred by you arising from any breach of these Terms or for any other reason, such liability is limited to the amount of the price of the Services concerned that you have actually paid to us.
- 6.3 We may agree to a higher limitation of liability with you than the limit provided in clause 6.2, but such agreement will only be effective if recorded in writing and signed on our behalf by an authorised signatory.
- 6.4 While every effort will be made to supply the Services, we will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from any representations or warranties, either express or implied and to the extent permissible by law we will not be liable for the merchantability or fitness for a specific purpose of the Services supplied and relied upon by you.
- 6.5 To the maximum extent permitted by law, you hereby indemnify, and forever hold harmless, us from all losses, liabilities costs and expenses caused or contributed to by any negligent and/or wilful act or omission or any breach of these Terms by you arising from the supply of the Services in accordance with these Terms.

7. **SITE**

- 7.1 You will be responsible for providing adequate and timely access to the Site and you will indemnify us against any loss, liability, costs and expenses incurred by us as a result of failing to provide such access.
- 7.2 If we, or our agents, enter the Site for the purposes of supplying the Services, you shall indemnify us for any loss, liability, costs and expenses incurred by us arising out of or in connection with such.

8. SAFETY

8.1 You are responsible for ensuring safe and adequate access to the Site for supply of the Services and all other aspects of Site safety.

- 8.2 You must notify us prior to supply of the Services of any obstacles or peculiarities in relation to the Site.
- 8.3 You must ensure that all personnel involved in, or in relation to, the supply and acceptance of the Services avoid contact with exposed skin areas and eyes and are wearing appropriate personal protection including but not limited to protective clothing, safety goggles and gloves.

9. YOUR ADDITIONAL OBLIGATIONS

- 9.1 You shall supply pumping concrete suitable for the Concrete Line Pump and supple ready mixed mortar to all prime lines.
- 9.2 You shall provide us with suitable and safe access to the Site, including adequate space for the Concrete Line Pump to be washed and cleaned and to further allow provision for the uninterrupted laying of pipes and pumping of concrete in accordance with the Services.
- 9.3 You shall be responsible for the removal and clean up of any waste associated with the provision of the Services at the Site.
- 9.4 You accept full responsibility for any liability associated with the following:
 - (a) the costs of removal of the Concrete Line Pump from the Site if the Concrete Line Pump becomes bogged;
 - (b) any delays in the provision of the Services caused by you, your employees, agents, contractors or subcontractors;
 - (c) any damage to the Site resulting from the provision of the Services;
 - (d) traffic management services required in relation to the supply of the Services to or at the Site; and
 - (e) all necessary restrictions, consents and approvals relating to the supply of the Services to or at the Site.

10. PRIVACY OF INFORMATION

- 10.1 You authorise us:
 - (a) to collect, retain and use information about you from any person for the purpose of assessing your creditworthiness;
 - (b) to disclose information about you (i) to any person who guarantees, or who provides insurance, or who provides any other credit support, in relation to your obligations to us; and (ii) to such persons as may be necessary or desirable to enable us to exercise any power or enforce or attempt to enforce any of our rights, remedies and powers under these Terms.

11. NOTICES

11.1 Any notice may be given by phone, in person, posted, or sent by facsimile or email to you or where you are a company, to any of your directors.

12. CONFIDENTIALITY

12.1 You shall at all times treat as confidential all non-public information and material received from us and shall not publish, release, or disclose the same without our prior written consent. For clarity, confidential information includes any our prices.

13. **COSTS**

13.1 You must pay our costs (including legal costs, as between solicitor and client) of and incidental to the enforcement or attempted enforcement of our rights, remedies and powers under these Terms.

14. CREDIT INFORMATION

14.1 You consent to us, or any financier or credit-rating agency, making enquiries of and obtaining any information about your financial standing and credit worthiness.

15. JURISDICTION

15.1 These Terms are governed by the laws of South Australia. You may take legal action against us only in a South Australian Court.

16. **DISPUTES**

16.1 Any claim or dispute arising under these Terms shall be determined by arbitration under the *Commercial Arbitration Act 2010* if the parties are unable to resolve such dispute themselves within one (1) month of the dispute arising. However, nothing in this clause prevents either party from taking immediate steps to seek any equitable relief before the South Australian Courts.

17. FORCE MAJEURE

- 17.1 If we have given you a time for supply of the Services, such time is approximate only and is not deemed to be of the essence.
- 17.2We shall not be liable for delay or failure to perform our obligations under these Terms if the cause of delay or failure is beyond our reasonable control.

18. **GENERAL**

- 18.1 These Terms replace any earlier representations, warranties, understandings and agreements (whether oral or written), and together with your customer application form and Quote (if any) constitute the entire agreement between us and you relating to their subject matter.
- 18.2 You shall not transfer or assign your rights, powers or obligations under these Terms without our prior written consent.

- 18.3 If you have entered into these Terms as the trustee of a trust and you have no right to or interest in any of the assets of the trust except in your capacity as trustee of the trust, your liability shall be limited to the value of the assets of the trust which now or in the future are (or, but for your wilful neglect or default, would be) in the hands of the trustees for the time being of the trust. This clause does not limit any liability you have to us as a personal guarantor.
- 18.4 No failure or delay by us in insisting upon the strict performance of these Terms or exercising any right under these Terms will operate as a waiver of those matters.
- 18.5 We may change these Terms at any time. Any change applies from when it is published on our website or notified to you in writing.

19. **DEFINITIONS**

- 19.1 In these Terms unless the context otherwise requires:
 - "Concrete Line Pump" means the concrete line pump used by us to supply the Services to you.
 - "Default" has the meaning set out in clause 4.
 - "Quote" means our quotation to supply the Services to you for a specified price (subject to adjustment in accordance with these Terms) and on these Terms as varied in the Quote.
 - "Schedule of Rates" means our schedule of rates for the supply of the Services and associated costs as issued and amended by us from time to time.
 - "Security" means all existing and future security held by us that secures your obligations under these Terms.
 - "Services" means the transfer, via our Concrete Line Pump, of concrete supplied by you, or on your behalf, at ground level at the Site. For the avoidance of any doubt, the Services do not in any way include setting the concrete in position or finishing the surface thereof.
 - **"Site**" means the location for supply of the Services specified in the order or Quote.
- 19.2 The rule of construction known as the contra proferentem rule does not apply to these Terms.
- 19.3 Words importing the singular include the plural and vice versa.
- 19.4 Headings are for convenience only and do not form part of, or affect the interpretation of, these Terms.
- 19.5 References to a party include that party's successors, personal representatives, executors, administrators and permitted assigns.
- 19.6 References to a statute include references to:
 - (a) regulations, orders, rules or notices made pursuant to that statute:
 - (b) all amendments to that statute and those regulations, orders, rules or notices, whether by subsequent statute or otherwise; and
 - (c) any statute passed in substitution of that statute.
